*Public comment may be presented at the time designated as "Public Input" on the agenda and must be related to those matters listed on the published agenda. No person may speak more than once to an issue or for a period longer than two minutes. No more than three people may be heard to one side of an issue. Individuals wishing to speak during this period must register with the Executive Assistant prior to the start of the meeting. The Board reserves the right to limit the total amount of time during which public comment will be heard at any meeting.

**Exemptions (a) Deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body. (b) Considering dismissal, demotion, licensing or discipline of any public employee or person licensed by a board or commission or the investigation of charges against such person, or considering the grant or denial of tenure for a university faculty member, and the taking of formal action on any such matter; provided that the faculty member or other public employee or person licensed is given actual notice of any evidentiary hearing which may be held prior to final action being taken and of any meeting at which final action may be taken. (c) Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility.
