

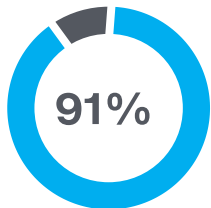

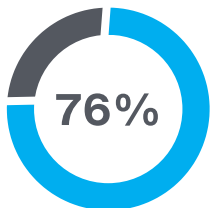

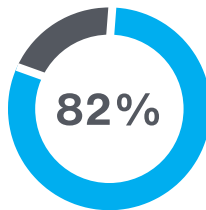

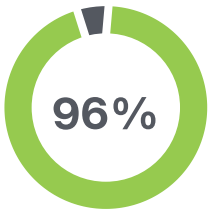


OF GRADS ARE EMPLOYED
IN WISCONSIN

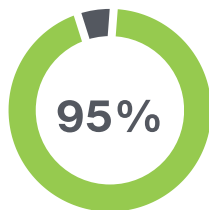
