Policy Statement <p>Students must complete the curriculum requirements to their specific program at the time they enter the program. If a student has a voluntary break from enrollment for three consecutive terms (beyond one year), their program will be discontinued, and the student will be withdrawn from the program. If a student returns to continue their program, they must re-apply and be admitted to the most current program curriculum.</p> <p>Any program accreditation and handbook will supersede the institutional Degree Progression policy.</p> <p>Students may appeal to the dean to be re-admitted to their previous matriculation term depending on if competencies remain the same, availability of courses, and related credit for prior learning experience. Any exceptions will be made at the dean’s discretion.</p>		
Reason for Policy <p>All academic programs at Lakeshore continuously undergo curriculum changes to keep current with technology, industry standards, and accreditation requirements. This policy ensures graduates are completing with the most recent and relevant curriculum.</p>
