Policy Statement Course placement scores or assessment through multiple measures are established by relevant college personnel. Student success and corresponding placement will be analyzed annually. The Student Resource Center and other resources are available to support the student prior to and during their program progression. Students will be placed in the appropriate course level based on standardized placement assessment levels following the college’s Multiple Measures Course Placement procedure .		
Reason for Policy The purpose of this policy is to ensure that students are placed in appropriate courses. Standardized tests alone may not be the most accurate measure for placing students into college-level courses.
